An "I" (Incomplete) indicates that work is satisfactory but, due to reasons beyond the student's control, some portion of the required work has been left incomplete. The instructor assigning the grade/stipulates to the student in writing, at the time the grade is given, the conditions under which the "I" may be removed.

For graduate students, a maximum of two (6 hours) concurrently held grades of Incomplete in courses other than [Internship or Practicum] is allowed. If this maximum is reached the student will be allowed to take only one three-hour course per term until the Incomplete total is reduced. Students who accumulate a total of three grades of Incomplete in courses other than thesis or dissertation, will be put on academic probation and not allowed to enroll further until the total is reduced.
